ANNUAL MEETING IS NEXT MONTH

We are fast approaching that time of year when we celebrate the 80-plus years of our electric cooperative and we would like you to join us.

Annual meetings are an opportunity we all look forward to in order for us to interact with our membership and share highlights from the past and current years (like being in our sixth straight year without a rate increase, for example!). Never in our history had we ever even thought about not planning a meeting in person — although Mother Nature has disrupted a few on the actual days — until last year when we were faced with a pandemic.

Again this year, we remained optimistic as long as we could and made all necessary preparations to be in Springfield next month. But, based on the moving target of government-imposed restrictions, we will again have to conduct an online meeting. Hopefully, it will be the last such occurrence. That said, every member can still attend and ask questions or make comments.

We will provide an operational and financial overview along with spotlighting some of our high school scholarship winners. Virtual meetings are not ideal, but they can be productive and enjoyable under these circumstances. Those who vote in the Director election will be eligible for prizes to be drawn during the meeting, and you don't even have to be online to win.

DON'T FORGET TO VOTE

Be on the lookout for a separate mailing later this month with Director ballots. It is a privilege to be part of an electric cooperative with its most basic principle and

benefit as democratic membership — so a vote is the most important contribution.

Over the years, I've naturally been approached by members for opinions related to an election. I once served on the board of another electric cooperative and currently serve on the board of the materials supply cooperative SECPA primarily buys from, so I do have some perspective on such a role. However, for obvious reasons in my purely management position, I do not actively campaign for or endorse any candidate. It is always best if the Directors and I are unbiased in our professional relationship, so I fully respect our cooperative's members deciding their own representatives.

On the other hand, I am equally available to any candidate as an information resource, as I am for any member. What I have always impartially expressed, whether in past articles or other venues, is the consistency and stability of our board throughout SECPA's history has seemingly been a key to longstanding success.

We had some natural turnover the past few years with two 20-plus-year Directors retiring and one 10-year Director resigning. The first replacement came after the incumbent chose to complete his term and not seek reelection. The others were appointed by the Board of Directors after a multiple-candidate interview process with appointees hoping to be ratified at the next scheduled election, as will be the case again this year. Of our current Board, whether originally elected or appointed, the four most experienced Directors have an average of almost 21 years of service. The remaining

three Directors have an average approaching two years, which seemingly blends a healthy mix of legacy and present-day perspectives. Their combined experience is 88 years of bringing a purely objective, member-only focus to cooperative governance. Ultimately, I am a member and, like you, will proudly cast my vote because it is essential in reinforcing the principles of our cooperative.

To further points I touched on last month on how we have evolved as an organization, I want to note that 2015 saw SECPA and SECOM staffing levels approaching 90 employees while still growing. This was primarily driven by an increased demand for broadband services but also by other steps needed to be an effective electric cooperative.

After an interim consolidation and transition of HR and safety responsibilities, Angela Bamber joined us in 2016 to develop a new role from the ground up. Then, until 2019, she also wore a second hat that included all safety programs until she created and hired a dedicated safety and compliance manager, who reports directly to her. She also has a payroll and benefits administrator to assist in fulfilling these specific responsibilities.

Angela graduated from Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction with a bachelor's in business administration. She held HR, supervisory and project management roles in the construction and retail industries, including Target and Lowe's prior to relocating to the Arkansas Valley to get married. She then led the STEM program at Otero Junior College. Her family, including husband Griff and 11-year-old Drake, reside in the La Junta home they are proudly remodeling themselves.

Angela is a no-nonsense professional who takes her responsibilities seriously. In addition to consistently offering ideas, she is valued for being proactive and assertive in addition to being a timely and successful project leader. 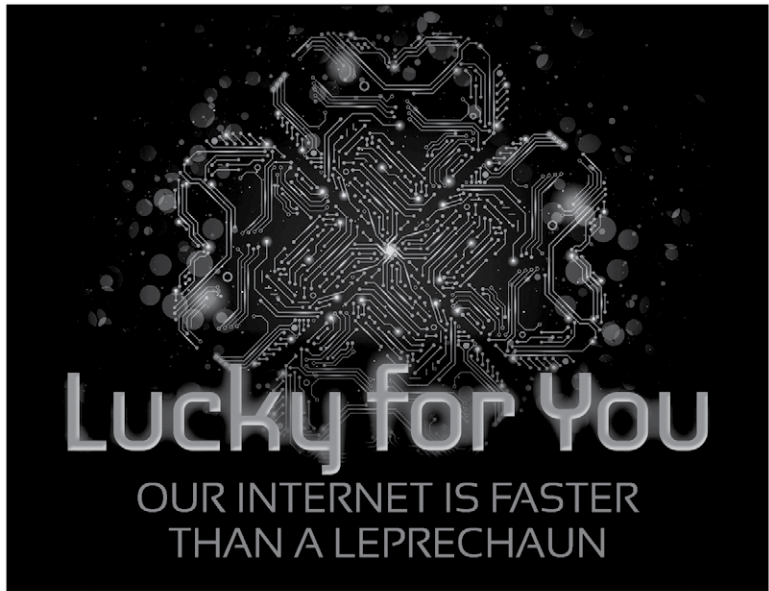
